

Medicare has rules that apply to rebates for thyroid ultrasound examinations. Medicare will only provide a rebate when the request form specifically includes one of the following suspected pathologies:

Item	Description
55032	Thyroid Ultrasound Where the service is provided, for the assessment of one or more of the following conditions or suspected conditions: i. Evaluation of palpable thyroid nodule or mass ii. Evaluation of abnormalities detected on other imaging regarding thyroid, parathyroid or neck masses iii. Follow up known thyroid nodule iv. Evaluation of presence, size and location of thyroid v. Screening of high-risk patients for occult thyroid malignancy vi. Localisation of Parathyroids in patients with hyperparathyroidism vii. Staging of thyroid cancer-Surveillance for recurrent disease for a patient with a history of thyroid cancer
	 Benefits are not payable when referred for: Abnormal thyroid function test Abnormal thyroid antibodies Symptoms such as sore throat, neck pain and globus pharyngeus-type symptoms
